MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE GENERALATE

From February 12 to 14, members of the Cabrini Global Health Commission met in Codogno to draw up a strategic plan for the coming year. The first part of the program consisted of an instructive visit to the Mother Cabrini Spirituality Center and a discussion on Mother Cabrini's spirituality led by Sr. Terezinha Esperança Merandi. Dr. Giuseppe Tansini and Sr. Concepcion presented the historical and current context of Mother Cabrini and MSCs in the health field. The days included a good discussion on the macro and micro elements that influence health care delivery and how to best support MSC-sponsored health ministries in their dynamic environments. The leaders of the health ministries joined via Zoom to share their perspectives in a synodical listening forum and Sr. Eliane shared the life and passion of MSCs with the members. Commission members left with a clear direction for developing a strategy and look forward to continuing to advise and support the MSCs in providing the healing love of Christ to the marginalized and vulnerable.

From February 21 to 25, Sr. Eliane and the General Council traveled to Barcelona to participate in a training course on positive leadership. They took the occasion to visit the city, particularly the Sagrada Familia and the Church of Santa Maria del Mar. Inside the church, much to their surprise, they found a beautiful wooden statue of Mother Cabrini!

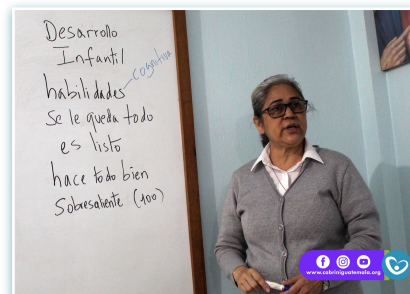

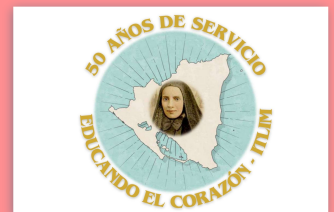

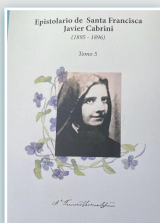

JANUARY 24 WORLD EDUCATION DAY

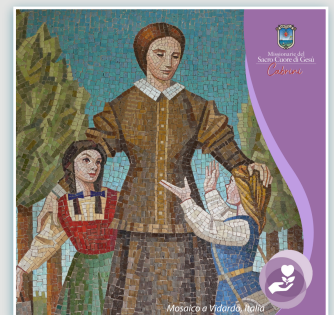

It all started in 1955 when benefactor Mr. Wolfington took an interest in Mother Cabrini. Then in 2020, he decided to make a film about the one he had selected as his patron saint. In 2021, he came to the Generalate in Rome to talk to us about this project in which he had made a large investment, and which he was pursuing with much research and filming, from Codogno to Rome. On February 25 last year, many sisters and lay people from all over Italy attended the preview screening of the film "Cabrini" by Alejandro Monteverde at the Lateran Pontifical University in Rome. Mr. Eustace Wolfington also spoke on that occasion, emphasizing the connection with the Saint. We were very privileged to be there to see the fruits of this great work. Twelve months later, the film dedicated to Mother Cabrini is finally being released in theaters in the United States. Angel Studios is distributing and promoting the film, soon to be released in most parts of the globe. The date chosen for the U.S., March 8, is very symbolic and fitting for the celebration of such a great woman as St. Frances Xavier Cabrini as she is and continues to be through her Daughters, the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Other release dates are March 8 in Australia and South Africa, March 15 in the United Kingdom, March 21 in Mexico, March 21 in Argentina and Paraguay, on March 22 in Brazil, and on April 4 in Guatemala and Nicaragua. The complete calendar with the film release dates can be found at www.cabriniworld.org and will be continuously updated. We invite you all to go to the movies and encourage your community, family, and friends to do so too, so that the figure of Mother Cabrini becomes more widely known and continues to inspire us and grow our mission in the world! This is our hope and, as Mr. Wolfington said, *"she taught us how to be happy by helping others. And those who are inspired by her become happier."*
