





Cabrinian November

The year 2025 marked the 145th anniversary of the Institute's foundation.

In the Province of St. Frances Cabrini:

On November 14, at the Colegio Boni Consilii, they celebrated this anniversary to commemorate the work inspired by the faith and courage of Mother Cabrini.

It was a morning of spirituality and gratitude, characterized by the participation of students from the fifth to the eighth grades, for whom it was a time of deep recollection and joy with the Eucharistic Celebration. We hope that Mother Cabrini's legacy will continue to illuminate our steps and inspire our educational mission. We also had a very special moment in Brazil on November 13 at the Casa Sagrado Coração de Jesus (the Novitiate)! We celebrated Saint Cabrini together with the CLMs and other lay people, combining it with the Wednesday rosary and the birthdays of Sister Lúcia Gzerbielucka and our collaborator, Josenildo.

The evening began with a beautiful reflection prepared by the novices, followed by the rosary, sharing, testimonies about Cabrini, the official photo and, of course, a delicious cake.

In anticipation of November 13, in Argentina we then celebrated the feast of Mother Cabrini with the added value of the voices of those who are actually living in it!

The children were asked if they knew any songs from school. And the answer was pure emotion, recollection and joy.

From kindergarten, elementary school and middle school they all joined together in a video that "sings what we are".

Because being Cabrinian means carrying the music of our history in our hearts.

In Paraguay, they celebrated Holy Mass on November 13 in the sisters' house and then on 14 November was the celebration of the renewal of the commitment of the Adult and Youth Missionaries and the leaders of the Refuge of Tenderness together with the

children. It was a blessed evening full of hope. The Holy Eucharist was presided over by Monsignor Joaquín Hermes Robledo, Bishop of the Diocese of San Lorenzo.



On November 13, the **Holy Spirit Region** joyfully joined the Cabrini family from all over the world to celebrate the feast of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini. This special day was celebrated in a unique and meaningful way everywhere in the region.

In **Ethiopia**, the sisters of Addis Ababa celebrated the feast with a special Mass in their Chapel, followed by a community lunch. Our sisters from Dubbo celebrated together with Cabrini Ministries Ethiopia and the sisters from Wallacha. This union exemplified the spirit of community and collaboration that Mother Cabrini nourished so passionately. The Sisters also joined the staff of St. Mary's Hospital in Dubbo to remind everyone of the importance of following Mother Cabrini's example and serving all patients with loving care. Mr. Tamirat W/Mariam, a member of the hospital's board of directors, presented Mother Cabrini's life and explained how we should continue to follow her example in our daily service, providing love and holistic care to all those who are lonely, neglected and marginalized, just as Mother Cabrini cared for them with tender love.

In **Sadama**, the celebrations also extended to the world of education. The sisters celebrated with the students and teachers of our kindergarten, creating an atmosphere of joy and learning. The day ended with a Mass and dinner within the community, bringing everyone together in unity and prayer. In **Eswatini**, the sisters joined Cabrini Ministries Eswatini and St. Philips parishioners for a day of shared devotion and community spirit. This celebration highlighted the strong ties within the Cabrini family and with their local communities. Our sisters in **Uganda** commemorated the feast together with refugees from the Pagirinya settlement. This act of kindness and inclusion embodied Mother Cabrini's mission to serve the needy and to nurture hope among immigrants, migrants, and refugees. Last but not least, our sisters in Kenya also participated in the celebrations, further extending the reach of Mother Cabrini's legacy throughout the region.





In the Mater Gratiae Province November 13, 2025 was a special day at the Cabrini Institute in Rome to remember our Saint, who with faith, courage and love was able to inspire many people. Children from the school celebrated this day with creativity, colors and much joy. In Spain, on November 13 and 14 they organized several theatrical performances.

In other parts of Spain, they also experienced this significant moment intimately. We began a journey of recollection and fraternity in this mission in Spain, the living heart of our Cabrinian presence, in particular from Calle Barquillo, where Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini founded her first college in Madrid. In particular in Spain, in addition to the November 13 and 14 feast days, the 125th anniversary of the birth of the Cabrini mission in Madrid was also celebrated (see section at the bottom of the newsletter). After reaching the Church of San José, a place dear to our foundress, a Eucharistic celebration was held and a painting dedicated to Mother Cabrini was inaugurated, now displayed in a special place in the church. The day ended at the Círculo de Bellas Artes, in an atmosphere of joy and communion.

In the Province of Guadalupe, November 13 was the feast of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini, a date set every year to honor the life and work of the saint also in the United States. Mother Cabrini's feast commemorates her mission to immigrant communities and her role as the first American citizen to be canonized.

At CIS-NYC in **New York**, this day has become a reminder of why our organization exists. Mother Cabrini, in fact, dedicated her life to supporting immigrant families through education, social services and community care.

Her work in New York laid the foundation for the services we continue to offer today such as legal counsel, social services, our food pantry, and leadership and advocacy programs.

In a video made last year to celebrate CIS-NYC's 25 years of service, Sr. Yolanda reflected on the life of Mother Cabrini and why her legacy continues to guide our community today. Donations can help continue to meet the needs of immigrant families in the neighborhood.

Also, on the occasion of the feast of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) issued "The Cabrini Pledge". It is an important statement on the obligation to apply immigration policy "in a humane way, without targeting those who work hard and respect the law, without allowing the gratuitous and unnecessary separation of families and without resorting to fear campaigns that paralyze entire communities".





In late October and early November, Sr. Eliane and the entire Council went to Madrid for the Educational Jubilee meetings and then made a stop in Rome. In mid-November, the entire General Council and Sr. Eliane traveled again to Madrid from November 12 to 15

for the 125th anniversary of the Cabrinian mission in Madrid and then on November 16, the entire Council and the General Superior moved to Codogno for the closing celebrations of the centenary of the consecration of the Tabor church. Sr. Eliane left for Brazil on November 21, while Sr. Stella Maris went to Argentina on November 20 and then on to Brazil in early December. The General Superior was also present at the celebration of the 60th anniversary of the *Obra Social Santa Cabrini* in Brazil together with Sr. Stella Maris at the beginning of December.

Sr. Patricia, on November 23, left for Kenya where she stayed until the first of December. Then from December 15 to 19 she was in Sant'Angelo Lodigiano and from 27 December to 1 January in Codogno. On December 20, at the Generalate in Rome, all the MSC sisters met to pray together, and exchange Christmas wishes. In attendance were Sr. Gilda, Sr. Patricia and the Secretary General, Sr. Giuditta, while Sr. Eliane and Sr. Stella Maris were connected remotely.

* On November 13 at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York, Cardinal Timothy Dolan unveiled a new mural by Brooklyn artist Adam Cvijanovic, the largest artwork ever commissioned for the Cathedral. Entitled "What's So Funny About Peace, Love, and Understanding," the mural pays tribute to Our Lady of Knock and the generations of immigrants whose faith has helped shape the city.

* On November 22, at the Teatro dell'Istituto Santa Francesca Saverio Cabrini in Via Anagni, our MSC school community celebrated the feast of Mother Cabrini with joy. From the preparations of all the sections to the actions of the boys and girls with gifts and questions, every moment expressed the beauty of a school that grows together, guided by the example of our Saint. The meeting with Cristina Odasso, interpreter of Mother Cabrini in the film Mother Cabrini (2019), was a precious emotional moment for the sisters, teachers and our students.

* On November 26 and 27, several Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus gathered in São Paulo, Brazil, for a meeting on Spiritual Discernment and provincial consultation for the three-year period 2026-2028. The meeting was coordinated by the General Superior, Sr. Maria Eliane, and the Assistant General, Sr. Stella Maris. The Mass was presided over by Father Mauro Vilela, who also acted as facilitator. During the first day, a conference and dialogue on Spiritual Discernment was given by Father João Renato Eith, S.J. It was a time for reflection, growth and communion in the mission.

* On November 5 and December 10, the second and third sessions of the Cycle of Communications Formation Meetings were held for the communications professionals of the Institute of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart of Jesus intended to strengthen technical and charismatic skills at the service of the Cabrini mission in the world.

In the second and third meetings Sr. Gilda Mercedes Mendoza Argueta, General Assistant of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, gave two in-depth speeches on the Cabrini legacy.

* On December 5 and 6, the sisters present in Argentina and Paraguay gathered at Casa Betania, Buenos Aires, Argentina. The meeting was also coordinated by the General Superior, Sr. María Eliane, and the Assistant General, Sr. Stella Maris. On the first day, a

conference and dialogue on spiritual discernment was held, led by Father Antonio Santillán, CMF Claretian Missionary, providing moments of deep reflection and spiritual strengthening.

* On Thursday, December 11 at 6:00 pm an "Incontro all'Africa" event of the Fondazione Maria Bonino was held in the "Maria Bonino" Council Chamber of the Province of Biella. The Regional Superior Sr. Barbara Staley also participated and gave testimony on the project to combat child malnutrition in Dubbo, Ethiopia, supported by the Foundation since 2023.

* On 11 December, the MSC community in Codogno also had the joy of welcoming Sr. Barbara Staley, who shared with them the great work carried out in the African missions.

It was an intense moment of listening and gratitude, an ideal journey through the realities of Ethiopia, Uganda and Swaziland where the Cabrini charism continues to take shape every day.

* On December 12, an important event took place at our Convent of the Sacred Heart in London when the Cabrini children of the Apostolate of the Catholic Mothers took the stage for the first time. This special performance marked an important milestone for both the children and their mothers.

The Convent of the Sacred Heart, a place steeped in history and tradition, provided the perfect backdrop for the event. The atmosphere was full of enthusiasm and expectation with 130 people gathered to attend the performance of the Cabrini children. The audience consisted of family, friends and supporters of the Apostolate of Catholic Mothers, all eager to witness this new chapter in the lives of children.

On November 16, we celebrated the *9th World Day of the Poor*. As Missionaries of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, let us remember that merciful love for the most vulnerable is at the heart of our mission. The Pope invites us to see every poor person through the eyes of Christ and to respond with compassion and hope.



At the 30th United Nations Conference on Climate Change (COP30), in Belém, Brazil, Pope Leo XIV called on world leaders to make concrete commitments to care for creation based on responsibility, justice and solidarity. Conveying the Pope's message, Cardinal Pietro Parolin, Secretary of State of the Holy See, told delegates: "If you want to cultivate peace, protect creation."

He affirmed that the Pope's words reflect the conviction that taking care of our common home is as much a moral duty as a path to lasting peace.



The video images made by the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network show us examples of an unshakable faith even amidst the rubble: the celebrations in Iraqi villages brought back to life, the strength of the parish community in Gaza and the indispensable work of Caritas in Lebanon among the poor and refugees.

ANNUAL 'MIGRANTES' REPORT PRESENTATION

On November 11, at the San Pio X hall in Rome, the 20th edition of the presentation of the *Italian Report in the World* of the Fondazione Migrantes was held.

After an introduction by the Director General of the Fondazione Migrantes, Msgr. Pierpaolo Felicolo, and the Prefect of the Dicastery for Communications of the Holy See, Dr. Paolo Ruffini, the moderator Delfina Licata of the Fondazione Migrantes spoke with several journalists exploring the issue of migration and clarifying the situation of migrants today.

Firstly, the Director of the 9 Columns Agency, Paolo Pagliaro, spoke and presented a short video on the Italians in the World Report. The round table entitled "Beyond the escape. Talents, brains or brawn?" with Roberto Incioccchi from Rai, Paolo Lambruschi from Avvenire and Manuela Perrone from Sole 24 Ore, moderated by Dr. Licata. The event was concluded by H.E. Msgr. Gian Carlo Perego, President of the Episcopal Commission for Migration of the CEI and the Fondazione Migrantes.

Cabrini, Global Education and Jubilee of the Educational World!

From October 27 to 29, the meeting "Cabrini, Global Education" took place. On October 28, this meeting went live at the Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini School in Madrid, with the participation of some pedagogical management managers, sisters representing the provinces, the General Superior and the General Assistants.

The General Superior, Sr. Eliane, spoke words of welcome. Subsequently, Sr. Nuria Miró and Sr. Mónica Horch, Missionary Daughters of the Holy Family of Nazareth, spoke on the Institutional Identity and the importance of the Educational Project for the creation of a Global Network of Schools. The managers of all the Cabrini schools actively participated in the various celebrations and meetings of the Jubilee of the Educational World. This Jubilee was a time for reflection and growth on education, spirituality and culture, highlighting Cabrini's commitment to a new culture of development and peace in education.

On Thursday October 30, after breakfast, the working group travelled from Madrid to Rome. In the afternoon a group of lay people from the Cabrini schools of Spain and Brazil participated in the International Congress "Constellation of Education – A Pact for the Future", as part of the Jubilee of the Educational World.

On October 31, an audience with the Holy Father in the Paul VI Hall was followed by an artistic and cultural path through the Sistine Wards of Santo Spirito in Sassia. On Saturday, November 1, a special Mass for the world of education was celebrated in St. Peter's Square, and the pilgrims passed through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica. In the afternoon, they visited and passed through the Holy Door of the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. On Sunday, November 2, however, the entire group from Spain participated in the Angelus at St. Peter's Square in the Vatican.
