The concept of the rehabilitation centre is in line with the philosophy applied to the bed-house of the Campus Waldkliniken Eisenberg: influence the relationship between physical space and well being. The rehabilitation centre will see a specific design to welcome orthopaedic patients and help them to recover. "La Piazza" will offer plenty space for patients' exercises being located at the centre point of the rehab building. Natural materials, an interaction of inside and outside, a delicate use of light and colour are designed to promote the healing process and have been united in a concept that is rarely found in hospital environments.
