The Discerning Leadership Program, the UISG and the USG, offer an online formation on leadership for Superiors General and General Councilors based in Africa and Latin America.


The formation will focus on the personal and spiritual leadership of the participants to enhance their capacity to lead their teams and congregations. For more information, please see below.

For a Congregation to participate, the Superior General of the Congregation must participate. We encourage the participation of at least two to three council members from each congregation.

A reliable internet connection is essential for following and participating in the sessions. The formation will consist of 24-sessions online spread over in 12 days.











Themes covered:

- Personal and Spiritual formation for Discerning Leadership
- Leading and managing Teams
- Communication and Conflict Resolution
- Organizational Culture and Development
- Discernment and Discernment in Common
- Intercultural Capacity
- Types of Personality
- Leading Change



The online formation combines inputs from experts, personal reflection time, and sharing with diverse peers.

Participants:

This online formation is targeted for up to 250 participants based in Africa and Latin America consisting of:

- Superior Generals
- General Councillors
- 1-2 members nominated by the General Council who would subsequently share the leadership formation, process and materials with other members of the congregation

It is greatly encouraged the participation of a group of at least 1-2 General Council members including the Superior General.

Language:

English, with simultaneous translations in French, Spanish and Portuguese, based on the demand.

Cost:

100€/person (25% discount for groups of 4+)
